Georgia Voter Qualifications

To register to vote in Georgia, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States.
- A legal resident of Georgia and of the county in which you wish to vote.
- 17 ½ years old.
(You must be 18 to vote.)

You cannot register to vote if you are:

- Serving a sentence imposed by a felony conviction.
- Judicially determined to be mentally incompetent.

Registering to Vote

You may only be registered to vote in one place.

1. The county of your hometown residence.
2. The county in which you live while away at college.

College students can also obtain Georgia voter registration forms, or the necessary forms to register in any state in the U.S. from their school registrar's office or from the office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs.

Registration Deadline: February 17, 2009

You should receive your precinct card within 3 weeks of submitting your voter registration application.

If you do not, check on the process of your voter registration application by calling your County Board of Registration. Your precinct card will list your polling location.

If you are already registered to vote at your current address, there is no need to register again.

3 Ways to Vote

Advance Voting

Georgia law allows you to vote the week prior to Election Day. Contact your County Board of Registration for times and locations.

Absentee (By Mail or In Person)

An absentee ballot allows you to vote in your home district when you are away from home (e.g. away for college, overseas for study abroad, military).

To vote absentee, download an absentee ballot application from the Secretary of State's website at: <http://sos.georgia.gov/ElectionCenter>, or contact the registrar in the county where you are registered to vote.

Once you complete the application you can submit the application by mail, fax, or in person.

An absentee ballot may be requested up to 180 days before Election Day. The last day to be issued an absentee ballot is the end of the business day on the Friday before the election.

Election Day

Polling locations are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. To find your poll location or your legislative districts, visit: <http://sos.georgia.gov/ElectionCenter>.

Photo ID

You must bring one of the following forms of identification with you when you vote in person:

- (1) A Georgia driver's license which was properly issued by the appropriate state agency;
- (2) A valid voter identification card or other valid identification card issued by a branch, department, agency, or entity of the State of Georgia, any other state, or the United States authorized by law to issue personal identification containing a photograph (**including student ID card from any public college or university**);
- (3) A valid United States passport;
- (4) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government, this state, or any county, municipality, board, authority, or other entity of this state;
- (5) A valid United States military identification card containing a photograph of the elector;
- (6) A valid tribal identification card containing a photograph of the elector.

If you do not have one of these forms of identification, you can get a free voter identification card from your county registrar's office.
