

The Georgia Board of Massage Therapy will accept passing scores on the following competency exams as one requirement for consideration of licensure in the state of Georgia to practice massage therapy:

National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodyworks (NCBTMB):

- National Certification Exam for Therapeutic Massage (NCETM), or
- National Certification Exam for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork (NCETMB)

Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB):

- Massage & Bodywork Licensing Exam (MBLEx)

NOTE: The Board will continue to review other exams as presented for discussion. A passing score on an exam is only one of several requirements for massage therapy licensure in Georgia.
